This is a fixed term 12-month contract position with a three month probation period.

Responsibilities:

- Manage the SRJC communications and media working groups.
- Update the annual Media Plan with realistic deliverables, in line with the organisation's three year Strategic Plan
- Collaborate closely with SRJC working groups and members to produce multimedia content
- Update mainstream and social media platforms, with good ability to make the necessary contacts within the various platforms
- Update, maintain and secure the website
- Oversee all official reporting for the Media Team and communications reporting for the SRJC including donor reports, the annual report, etc.
